PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

Be an Example of Perseverance, not Perfection

1 Timothy 4:12: "Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity."

Romans 5:3-4: "We can rejoice, too, when we run into problems and trials, for we know that they help us develop endurance. And endurance develops strength of character, and character strengthens our confident hope of salvation."

These scriptures are ones that we come back to again and again here at Grace Christian Academy. It is inevitable that in any given week, I will be discipling with these verses to someone at school. However, more often than not, I find this scripture discipling me.

As humbling as it is, this is the reality of being an administrator and teacher within a discipleship ministry such as Grace Christian Academy. As you disciple people, God disciples you. God knows that people are watching us because it is human nature to observe. So, He wants us to be a good example, as it says in 1 Timothy 4:12. However, He also knows that we are all imperfect and will falter. So, He wants us to persevere also, as it says in Romans 5:3-4. I think all of us can answer honestly that there are times we run the race well and other times we do not. Fortunately, God is not keeping score (even though, unfortunately, we still do). God understands that each of us will have moments when we fall on our face, but we need to remember that the point is not perfection. He does not call us into commissions because we have finally reached nirvana. No, the point is to remember the One who makes us perfect and to get up and try, with Him, again. As we persevere, we develop endurance; endurance shapes character; and character strengthens and portrays our hope of salvation through Jesus Christ to others. Perseverance produces the example, not perfection. The perfection comes through Christ and Christ alone.

We have to remember that we have been declared holy by the blood of Jesus Christ. In the Sermon on the Mount, in Matthew 5:48, Jesus said, "Therefore you shall be perfect, just as your Father in heaven is perfect." What??! Perfect, as our Father is perfect?? Isn't that bar set pretty high? Yes, it is. In fact, the bar is set so high that it is impossible for us to reach. So let's stop thinking that we need to attain perfection to be made right before God and let our intercessor, Jesus Christ, go before us to declare it is finished, by His death and resurrection. When we do this, then Jesus can work in and through us. It is through our weakness that He is made strong (2 Corinthians 12:9-10).

At GCA, we celebrate that God is not calling us to be perfect. And because of HIS holiness, we are made holy! Oh how we need to walk in this truth daily! Let us praise our Lord for what He has done, come to Him daily to remember His promise, and persevere to keep our eyes on the true prize--Jesus Christ. That is the example He is looking for.

Let's continue to Leave a Legacy of Walking with Christ!


